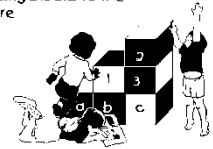

- Christmas Movie Nights

The response to the Movie Nights has been tremendous and the nights have proved very popular. As a result all the children who returned a slip have been allocated one night only. All tickets for Thursday 30th November have now been allocated. Places need to be paid for, via Parentpay, by Wednesday 29th November. Places will not be held after Wednesday if not paid for. We have a waiting list and any unpaid places will be offered to the next child on the list. We will update Thursday 7th December movie night next week

- **Christmas Lunch**

We will be having our Christmas Lunch on Thursday 7th December. More details will follow nearer the time, but we are inviting the children to wear their Christmas jumpers for the day

- **Year 1 & 2 Nativity Performance - 'The Hopeless Camel'**

The Year 1 & 2 Nativity Service will take place on Sunday 10th December. The infant children will be leading the morning service by giving a performance of their nativity play, 'The Hopeless Camel'.

There will be a performance of the play at 2:00pm during the afternoon of Friday 8th December for Senior Citizens and Grandparents only. Any donations of mince pies would be gratefully received on the morning of Friday 8th December for us to serve to our guests.

Please note that, as space is limited, parents should only come to the Sunday morning performance.

- **Foundation Stage Christmas Concert** - This year the Reception & Nursery children will be having 2 performances of their Christmas Concert on Tuesday 12th December at 10:00am and 2:00pm. Ticket information will be sent nearer the time.

- **Christmas Parties** - Parties take place during the afternoon - on Wednesday 13th December for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 and Thursday 14th for the Juniors. The children should come into school in the morning of their respective parties already dressed in their party clothes.

The Nursery party will take place on Monday 18th December from 9:00-11:00am for morning session and 1:00-3:00pm for the afternoon session.

- **Lighting of Cronton Christmas Tree and Village Ecumenical Service** - this will take place on Tuesday 12th December starting with the lighting of the tree at 7:00pm. Rosie Reynolds, our Christmas Card competition winner, will be our Guest of Honour and help perform the switch - on, alongside the winner from Holy Family School. The carol service itself begins at 7:30pm sharp in Holy Family Church and will be led by children from both schools. The service will last approximately 45 minutes so if you are not staying please ensure your child is collected at 8:15pm.

- **Breakfast with Santa** - On Thursday 21st December the infant children will come into school as normal and after registration will go into the hall to have a bowl of cereal and a drink of milk or water. Santa has promised to visit us and all the classes after breakfast.
