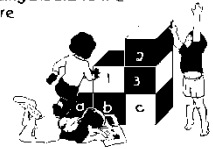

Christmas Dates for Diary

- Christmas Movie Nights

Last night was very successful which was due to the hard work of the Friends Committee and Parent supporters. If your child is due to attend next week, I would ask that you remind them of the standard of behaviour that we expect so that a good and safe time is had by all.

All spaces have been filled for next week. Please make sure places are paid for via Parentpay, by Wednesday 6th December at the latest, if you haven't already done so. Places will not be held after Wednesday if not paid for. The children can bring their pj's/ onesies etc to get changed into in class after school. Please make sure they are in a named bag. But **PLEASE** do not send in any pillows or teddies - we cannot look after these whilst looking after the children. There will be mats available for the children to sit on but they do not need any blankets.

- Christmas Lunch

We will be having our Christmas Dinner next Thursday - 7th December. There is the option for your child to have Quorn chicken as an alternative to the turkey if your child is a vegetarian. There will be no alternative to the Christmas Dinner so if your child does not wish to have this you will have

to provide them with a packed lunch. It would be great if the children to wear their Christmas jumpers for the day.

- **Year 1 & 2 Nativity Performance - 'The Hopeless Camel'**

The Year 1 & 2 Nativity Service will take place on Sunday 10th December. The infant children will be leading the morning service by giving a performance of their nativity play, 'The Hopeless Camel'. There will be a performance of the play at 2:00pm during the afternoon of Friday 8th December for **Senior Citizens and Grandparents only**. Any donations of mince pies would be gratefully received on the morning of Friday 8th December for us to serve to our guests.

Please note that, as space is limited, parents should only come to the Sunday morning performance.

- **Foundation Stage Christmas Concert** - This year the Reception & Nursery children will be having 2 performances of their Christmas Concert on Tuesday 12th December at 10:00am and 2:00pm. Ticket information will be sent nearer the time.

- **Mince Pies** If you could spare a box of mince pies for our carol concerts, nativity and foundation concert we would be very grateful. Please pass any donations onto your child's class Teaching Assistant before next Friday - 8th December.

- **Christmas Parties** - Parties take place during the afternoon - on Wednesday 13th December for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 and Thursday 14th for the Juniors. The children should come into school in the morning of their respective parties already dressed in their party clothes. But please make sure they wear sensible shoes - no heels please.

The Nursery party will take place on Monday 18th December from 9:00-11:00am for morning session and 1:00-3:00pm for the afternoon session.

- **Lighting of Cronton Christmas Tree and Village Ecumenical Service** - this will take place on Tuesday 12th December starting with the lighting of the tree at 7:00pm. Rosie Reynolds, our Christmas Card competition winner, will be our Guest of Honour and help perform the switch - on, alongside the winner from Holy Family School. The carol service itself begins at 7:30pm sharp in Holy Family Church and will be led by children from both schools. The service will last approximately 45 minutes so if you are not staying please ensure your child is collected at 8:15pm.

- **Breakfast with Santa** - Even though he is extremely busy at this time of year, on Thursday 21st December the infant children will come into school as normal and after registration will go into the hall to have a bowl of cereal and a drink of milk or water. Santa has promised to visit us and all the classes after breakfast. We are all very excited to see him.
