

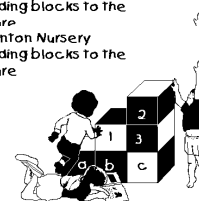

Scarlet Fever

We have had a couple of cases of Scarlet Fever confirmed recently. Scarlet fever is very contagious. Symptoms include sore throat, headache, high temperature, swollen glands and vomiting. This may be followed by a rash on the body, a red face and a white or red tongue. The treatment is usually antibiotics for 10 days. Children can return to school once they have been on the antibiotics treatment for 24 hours.

Website / Online Safety

You may have seen in the news this week a report from the National Crime Agency about how they are tackling child sexual exploitation and abuse. It was reported that operations in one week involving the police and NCA across the UK, safeguarded 245 children and 192 people were arrested. The long term aim for the NCA is that nowhere online is safe for people out to groom children or view them being abused.

In an online NCA survey, 84% of parent respondents said they were alert to the potential dangers their children face online. But child protection experts are warning that knowledge goes out of date more quickly than many people realise because the online environment is now changing so quickly. The survey also showed that while the majority of parents speak to their children regularly, over 30% had not spoken to their children about online safety in the last month. Almost 58% are not sure if they have adequate online security.

In school we regularly discuss online safety in our lessons. As always, if you need any help or support, please see our online-safety blog or call in and speak to us. We will be re-launching our e-cadet scheme after Christmas. Mrs Edwards

Dinner Money (£9.50 per week / £1.90 per day)

If you have lost your log in details please speak to Mrs Hooks in the school office. If you have any problems logging in please click on the 'help & support' section on the main page of the website. We now have 1 week and 4 days up to the end of the term. This means that lunches will cost £17.10.

If you know that your child will be absent during this period you should deduct £1.90 for each day's absence.

Please remember if your child wishes to stay for school lunch they must stay for the week; they are unable to alternate between school dinners and packed lunches in the same week.

Reception Admissions - September 2018

Parents / carers must complete the application form from the council in which they live regardless of which school they wish to apply to. We recommend that parents you can apply on-line.

If you live in any other borough, i.e. Halton, you will need to contact that relevant council direct.

This means:

- **Knowsley Residents** - If you live in the borough of Knowsley you must only complete a Knowsley application form. You can apply direct online at www.knowsley.gov.uk/schooladmissions. Parents need to list the schools they wish to be considered for in order of preference on the application form. If you complete a paper application form please return the application form to the school office.
- **Halton & other Borough Residents** - If you live in Halton or any other Borough to Knowsley you must only complete an application form and return it to your home Borough Council, or go online and complete a form there. Parents need to list the schools they wish to be considered for in order of preference. If you wish to apply for your child to attend this school please name our school in your list of preferences.

The closing date for applications is **Monday 15th January 2018.**

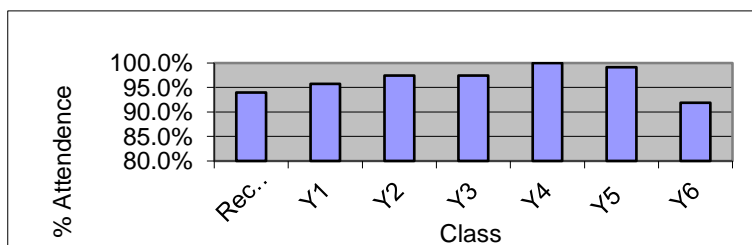
