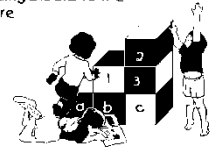

Nativities and Concerts

We have received many complimentary remarks and such positive feedback regarding all our productions / concerts. Our children are certainly a credit to our parents and our school.

Christmas Parties

Parties take place during the afternoon - on Monday 17th December for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 and Tuesday 18th for the Juniors. The children should come into school in the morning of their respective parties already dressed in their party clothes (except the choir as detailed below).

Choir Singing

Our choir will be giving a carol concert at Liverpool airport at 10:00am on Tuesday 18th December. The choir should wear their normal uniform to school, bringing their party clothes in a named carrier bag to change into later. If possible we would like the children to wear a Christmas hat or headbands / diddlyboppers please.

Lighting of Crnton Christmas Tree and Village Ecumenical Service

This will take place on Tuesday 18th December starting with the lighting of the tree at 7:00pm. Blythe Lyons will be our Guest of Honour and help perform the switch - on, alongside the winner from Holy Family School. The carol service itself begins at 7:30pm sharp in Holy Family Church and will be led by children from both schools. The service will last approximately 45 minutes so if you are not staying please ensure your child is collected at 8:15pm.

Cronton's Got Talent

We will be having 2 live shows for the children in school on the mornings of Wednesday 19th & Thursday 20th December, hopefully your child/ren have been polishing up their act. If your child is taking part in the show and they need a costume, they should bring their

costumes in a named carrier bag but must wear uniform the rest of the day. If they need music for their act, they should bring in a named cd no later than Tuesday 18th December.

Christmas Lunch

We will be having our Christmas Dinner on Wednesday 19th December. There is the option for your child to have Quorn chicken as an alternative to the turkey if your child is a vegetarian. The pudding will be Snowman Ice-Cream.

There will be no alternative to the Christmas Dinner so if your child does not wish to have this you will have to provide them with a packed lunch.
