## E-Safety

Video games are among the most — if not THE most — popular entertainment medium for young people, and children are graduating to online gaming at ever earlier ages. With voice chat, online games like Fortnite, FIFA and Minecraft are evolving into social spaces where children meet with their friends — and make new ones. It can be great fun - but it's important that parents are aware how to manage the associated risks.


Not everyone in in-game chats has good intentions, and there are a few things to be aware of if your child is using in-game chat functions, such as online bullying and online grooming. All games consoles feature parental and privacy settings that you can adjust so that your child can only communicate with people on their friends' list - check online for information about your child's console. Below are some tips for where, or who, you could report any e-safety issues.

Blocking and reporting: get to know the reporting mechanisms of the game they're playing first, and encourage them to quickly block and report anyone who harasses them, or makes them uncomfortable. If you come across something you suspect might be online grooming, go to the [NCA-CEOP](#) site where you quickly report it. Keep a record of the abuse - take screenshots of text messages, for example. Reporting tools vary depending on the game but they're normally easy to find. If a game doesn't have them, it's probably best to avoid it.

Next Tuesday 5th February is Safer Internet Day. All the children will be taking part in various activities which will be uploaded throughout the day on our Twitter page. Make sure you are following @cromptoncschool to see all of the amazing work your children do. Thank you, Miss Bird.
